The English Ceramic Circle, founded in 1927, is a registered charity dedicated to the study of the origins of British Ceramics and Enamels and their development up to the present day.

The Circle promotes the spread of knowledge on British ceramics and enamels through lectures, exhibitions and visits to both public and private collections. We meet once a month in London from October until April and normally organise a summer collection visit and an annual exhibition. Exhibition topics change annually and may be accompanied by the publication of a catalogue.

Papers presented at monthly meetings are normally published annually in the Transactions of the Circle which are sent to all Members free of charge. Papers and research can also be published on the ECC's website www.englishceramiccircle.org.uk. and members can communicate with each other and share their interests and research through a web forum.
